An essential part of a successful scientist is being able to communicate your work to a variety of audiences in a range of modes. In this 3-session workshop we will work together to improve our practice in this also discussing concrete and relevant examples of your own work.

The goal of these explorations is not critique but to explore the many ways you can communicate an idea and the strengths and weaknesses of each approach. We hope to have a chance to discuss papers, posters, slide talks, abstracts, and classroom teaching - although we may not get to all of these, the core principles we discuss apply across all of them. The course will be quite interactive, and shaped by the group's needs, so don't worry about what to expect, we'll do it together!
